## 6.1. PCIN Board Meeting - November 8, 2023

PCIN Board members met virtually on November 8, 2023 with three primary agenda items to discuss:

- Board By-laws—These are outlined in the Ontario Public Libraries Act, 1990;
- 2024 PCIN Budget—The operating and capital budgets for PCIN were reviewed and approved;
- Strategic Plan—The PCIN Strategic Plan process is underway, and a Sub-Committee will review community information and strategic plans

from all Perth County public libraries to create a mutual mission, vision, list of values, and strategic priorities to guide PCIN decisions for the duration of the Plan.

## 6.2.2024 Budget Update

The Municipality of West Perth Council discussed the 2024 Operating Budget submissions for all municipal departments and the Library on December 11, 2023. There were no concerns related to the Library's budget submission at that time. Capital budget discussions took place on January 15, 2024, and Municipal Council will review and discuss the 2024 Budget in the coming weeks.

## **8.1.** Freedom of Information

## 8.2. Advocacy

West Perth Public Library looks for partnership and advocacy opportunities to address community needs and interests. Further to this, the Library seeks to bring provincial and federal services to West Perth for the convenience of all its residents. Recent new partnerships include the following:

 Tim Hortons Holiday Smile Cookie Campaign took place in November 2023, with half the proceeds from Mitchell Tim Hortons donated to West Perth Public Library;

- Stovel-Siemon Ltd is sponsoring the Library's Snack Sharing Shelf from January to June 2024;
- Service Canada will come to West Perth Public Library on the fourth Tuesday of each month beginning in 2024, to assist with passports, Employment Insurance and Canada Pension Plan queries, and other Service Canada programs and products;
- Free Tax Clinics: In partnership with Huron Perth Public Health,
   Poverty2Prosperity and the United Way Perth Huron, West Perth Public
   Library hopes to offer free tax clinics beginning in 2024 to qualifying
   residents. Volunteer tax assistants are required for this to move forward;
- Dungeons & Dragons: Weekly sessions of Dungeons & Dragons at the West Perth Youth Centre have grown exponentially in recent months.
  More and more youth and volunteers enjoy this immersive game of strategy and imagination;
- Sciensational Sssnakes! was a special presentation hosted at the West Perth Community Centre in November. Young families had a wonderful time exploring the world of snakes and reptiles;
- The Annual 'Noon' Year's Eve Party at the end of December specifically caters to young children and caregivers by ringing in the New Year as a daytime event at the West Perth Community Centre.

West Perth Public Library is grateful to all volunteers and partner organizations who help to bring fun, educational, affordable programs and services for all ages into the community.
