8.2. Advocacy

West Perth Public Library looks for partnership and advocacy opportunities to address community needs and interests. Further to this, the Library seeks to bring provincial and federal services to West Perth for the convenience of all its residents. Recent collaborations include the following:

- As of May 2024, West Perth Public Library is a year-round, drop off/pick up and virtual location for those who qualify for free tax clinics through the Community Volunteer Income Tax Program (CVITP) with volunteers trained through the Canada Revenue Agency;
- West Perth Public Library now lends a free family community pass to the Stratford-Perth Museum to library cardholders;
- Municipal Town Hall is featuring the Library in its glass display case in the entrance vestibule for the month of June. Town Hall features a different public service each month to highlight the community resources available to all West Perth residents;
- West Perth Public Library will offer family-friendly programs during the 'Mitchell 150' anniversary festivities this summer;
- Patrons are enjoying the free community passes offered through the Library, providing opportunities to plan excursions in and around Perth County.

West Perth Public Library is grateful to all volunteers and partner organizations who help to bring fun, educational, affordable programs and services for all ages into the community.
