6.1. 2024 Valuing Ontario Libraries Toolkit (VOLT) Social Return on Investment In 2023, the Ontario Library Service introduced a toolkit for public libraries to evaluate their annual statistics to measure social impact. Tailored algorithms and formulae—created by the Ontario Library Service and the Nordik Institute—evaluate annual statistics to measure a community's social return on investment (SROI) for its library's many resources. The SROI is shown in dollar values that the library provides to individuals and households per open hour per year.

The CEO will present 2024 West Perth Public Library VOLT results to the Library Board at its April 15, 2025 meeting.
