# 8.1. Advocacy

- Perth County Reads literacy activities for all ages continued throughout the fall to promote Dan Needles' book, *Finding Larkspur*. The contest to join the author for lunch has now closed;
- New community pass:
  - Kustermans Adventure Farm pass is valid from April to December, offering free admission for up to four people to the family-friendly venue in Mount Brydges;
- Paws 4 Stories: The Library will host a service animal from the St. John Ambulance and its handler each Thursday evening in November. Schoolaged children read to a service animal to practice reading and literacy skills;
- Dungeons & Dragons: This program, in partnership with the Youth Centre, continues to be very popular. The Youth Centre is looking for additional volunteers to assist on Monday evenings.

West Perth Public Library is grateful to all volunteers and partner organizations who help to bring fun, educational, affordable programs and services for all ages into the community.
